Organs to be demonstrated: Uterus, gestational sac, fetal structures, placenta, cervix, Rt. adnexa, Lt. adnexa

*Procedure done Trans-Abdominally, if cervix not well seen, do translabial or transvaginal to document length and show closed external os.

*Always document Fetal Lie & Placenta Location

1. **Sagittal Uterus**
2 images cervix (r/o previa)
1 image entire uterus
 2. **Transverse Uterus**
1 image vag
1 image cervix
2 images uterus
 3. **Placenta**
2 images placenta location
 4. **Obstetrical Measurements**
2-3 images TRV head with BPD
& Head Circumference
2-3 images Abdominal Circumference
2-3 images femur length
2 M-Mode
Make a note of amniotic fluid level
- *No ovary images necessary, unless specified on order
* If unable to visualize cx transabdominally, scan transvaginal or transperineal to document if os is closed
