Organs to be documented: Uterus, Placenta, Cervix, Fetal Structures, Measurement, and Adnexa

<u>1. Sagittal Uterus</u> 5. Fetal Structures Images of: 2 images cervix (r/o previa) Extremities-document all 4 1 image entire uterus Bladder 2. Transverse Uterus Cord Insertion 1 image vag. 3 Vessel Cord 1 image cervix Stomach 1 image uterus **Kidneys** 4 Chamber Heart with outflow tracts (rvot/lvot) Spine (C,T,L,S) in TRV and Sag 3. Placenta 2 images placenta-location Nose/Lips (coronal) Cerebellum Cisterna Magna 4. Fetal Measurements 2-3 images TRV head with BPD Nuchal Fold and head circumference Lateral Ventricles w/choroid plexus 2-3 images abdominal circum. 2-3 images femur length 2 M-mode -make a note os amniotic fluid -make a note of fetal movement

*BPD should show falx and cavum septum pellucidum

*Procedure done Trans-abdominally, if cervix not well seen, do translabial or transvaginal ultrasound to document length and show closed external os.

*Always document fetal lie and placenta location
