

CT FACE - TRAUMA- ORBITS

GE - 2001

Maximum CTDI 62

Remove all metal objects from head to eliminate artifacts

PT Prep: Scout AP and LAT-supine (head first) "O" at 0M S 100 to 1100

Series 1 : Axial scan of the face from the tip of the chin thru the frontal sinus. Be sure to include all of the mandible and TMJ. Raise the chin slightly so facial structures are parallel to the beam of the scan.

Series 2: No angle should necessary.
When order states Orbits, start scan at the hard palate.

If IV contrast indicated follow MCR contrast dosing guidelines.
